#### Common Indianisms and Their Alternatives

### Time & Schedule Related

Indianism	Professional Alternative	Example Usage
"Prepone"	"Move earlier", "Advance"	X "Can we prepone the meeting?" ✓ "Can we move the meeting earlier?"
"Today itself"	"Today", "Right away"	X "I will complete it today itself" ☑ "I will complete it today"
"Yesterday itself"	"Yesterday"	X "I sent the email yesterday itself"  ✓ "I sent the email yesterday"
"Do the needful"	"Please handle this", "Please take care of this"	➤ "Please do the needful" ■ "Please take care of this"

### Email & Written Communication

Indianism	Professional Alternative	Example Usage
"Kindly revert"	"Please reply", "Please respond"	<ul><li>➤ "Kindly revert at the earliest"</li><li>✓ "Please respond at your earliest convenience"</li></ul>
"Please revert back"	"Please respond", "Please reply"	➤ "Please revert back with your thoughts"  "Please share your thoughts"
"Gentle reminder"	"Friendly reminder", "Quick reminder"	<ul><li>X "This is a gentle reminder"</li><li>✓ "This is a friendly reminder"</li></ul>

"As discussed"	"As per our discussion", "Following our discussion"	<ul><li>X "As discussed, sending details"</li><li>✓ "Following our discussion, I'm sending the details"</li></ul>
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## Meeting & Conversation

Indianism	Professional Alternative	Example Usage
"Good name?"	"What is your name?"	X "May I know your good name?" ✓ "May I know your name?"
"Tell me your convenient time"	"What time works best for you?"	"Tell me your convenient time for meeting"     "What time works best for you for the meeting?"
"I am having doubt"	"I have a question"	X "I am having one doubt" ✓ "I have a question"
"Small request"	"Quick request", "Brief request"	<ul><li>X "I have one small request"</li><li>✓ "I have a quick request"</li></ul>

# Career & Education

Indianism	Professional Alternative	Example Usage
"Passed out in 2020"	"Graduated in 2020"	<ul><li>X "I passed out from college in 2020"</li><li>✓ "I graduated in 2020"</li></ul>
"Give exam"	"Take exam", "Sit for exam"	<ul><li>X "I will give IELTS next month"</li><li>✓ "I will take the IELTS exam next month"</li></ul>
"Basic salary"	"Base salary"	➤ "What is the basic salary?" ✓ "What is the base salary?"
"Out of station"	"Out of town", "Away"	<ul><li>X "I will be out of station next week"</li><li>✓ "I will be out of town next week"</li></ul>
